## County Clerk Warns Residents About Deed Scam

"Nassau County Clerk Maureen O'Connell wants to caution homeowners about mass mailings being sent out claiming "The U.S. Government Federal Citizen Information Center website recommends that property owners should have an official or certified copy of their deed." These letters urge homeowners that it is necessary to purchase a certified copy of the deed to their home. It is not necessary to retain a service to get a copy of your deed. Certified copies of deeds can always be obtained from the County Clerk's Office for \$5 to \$10. Anyone wishing to request a certified copy of their deed can contact Clerk O'Connell's office at 516-571-2664 for further information."
